

ERASMUS PROJECT – Mobility in Czech republic

The activities took place in czech school in the second week of May and were aimed at fulfilling the outputs of our project – communication in english and national languages, creating a joint anthem of our project, exchanging good practice between teaching staff. The others activities included visits to cultural monuments in the vicinity of our village. On the first day, a we welcame our partners with a cultural program in the school gym. This was followed by a joint meeting with the presentation of the activity plan for the whole week, and then the students worked in groups, In each group were members of all of partenrs countries. They made art and creative activities, an activity with 3D glasses, quizzes and more. In the end, we presented a joint solution. In the morning every day, students and teachers had the opportunity to visit classes. On the fourth day of the meeting, a joint activity took place - the singing of national songs and a joint project song in all national languages. In two days, we implemented a cultural program with international activities in the art center in Olomouc. During it, students could get to know Czech culture and tradition in detail. We implemented ecursions in Olomouc, Kroměříž and Šternberk. At the end, there was an evaluation of the project and the handing over of certificates. Pupils of 8th - 9th grades, a total of 20 from the Czech Republic, and then pupils and teachers from partner schools were involved in the activities.

The participants of the activity improved their conversation in English, and had the opportunity to learn about the traditions and culture of the host country. They learned mutual cooperation, they had the opportunity to learn the basics of communication in the Czech language. Both teachers and students visited classes at our school and had the opportunity to compare with their own practice. They developed their abilities in the field of music education, developed conversation in the English language, worked with ICT tools such as tablets and 3D glasses. As part of the program, students had the opportunity to develop their artistic skills, they learned to understand the culture of our country through works of art.
